From Green Party members in Ukraine Solidarity Campaign

Not long ago a hundred drone and missiles strikes on Ukraine a night was considered bad. Now, after Donald Trump literally rolled out the red carpet for Vladimir Putin, we are regularly seeing 400, 500 or more. Ukraine is under brutal imperialist assault.

Russia's war has meant tens of thousands of civilian deaths (plus tens of thousands of Ukrainian and hundreds of thousands of Russian soldiers); many more injuries; millions of refugees and displaced people; and vast social and ecological destruction. It is more important than ever to stand with the Ukrainians' fight against invasion and occupation, as with the Palestinians and all peoples facing violence and oppression.

Since the full-scale invasion in 2022, Ukraine Solidarity Campaign has raised hundreds of thousands of pounds to support both Ukrainian front-line defenders and essential workers behind the lines (firefighters and rescue workers, health workers, education workers, miners and others) – working with Ukrainian and UK trade unions to do so.

We're currently raising money for i) a vehicle to be converted for use by a rapid response unit intercepting drones and missiles to protect the population near one of Ukraine's frontlines and ii) another for a rescue squad in Donetsk oblast, also near the front. This at the request of trade unionists and democratic socialists in the industrial city of Kryvyi Rih.
